The club believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators, volunteers and parents/guardians associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. All members and their guests must play within the rules and respect these guidelines drawn up by the committee. Most of the following rules are concerned with safety.

- If you leave your child at Bexley Lawn Tennis, Squash & Racketball club unattended they are being left at their own risk.
- Your child is the responsibility of the coach only during the specified time of their lesson and not after or before the lesson.
- If your child is under the age of 8 years old then a parent or guardian needs to remain on the premises of the club during the duration of the lesson.
- You must treat your fellow club members with respect, and behave responsibly and safely whilst at the club. You must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs or sexual identity.
